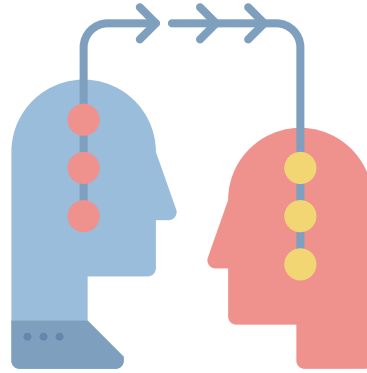

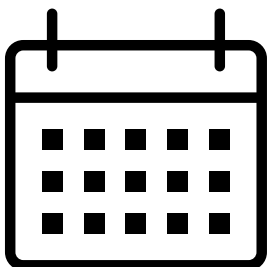


January- Human Trafficking & Stalking Awareness Months

- This month, we join the nationwide call to action to elevate awareness, strengthen our communities, and support survivors.
- National Stalking Awareness Month: An estimated 13.5 million people are stalked in a one-year period in the United States. Stalking is a pattern of behavior directed at a specific person that would cause a reasonable person to fear for the person's safety or the safety of others; or suffer substantial emotional stress.

- Human Trafficking Prevention Month: In 2021, 10,359 situations of human trafficking were reported to the U.S. National Human Trafficking Hotline involving 16,554 individual victims. Sex trafficking is the crime of using force, fraud or coercion to induce another individual to sell sex.
