Use your voice to support survivors and the programs that serve them by **urging support for an increased funding for domestic violence services.**

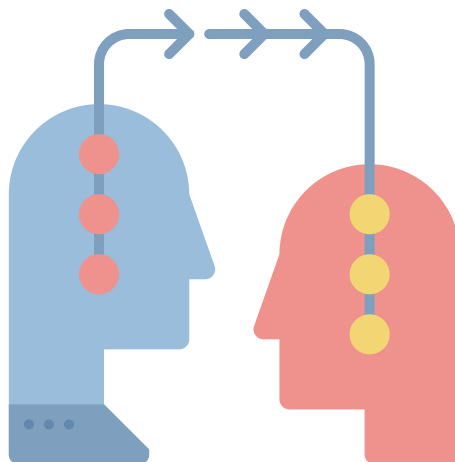

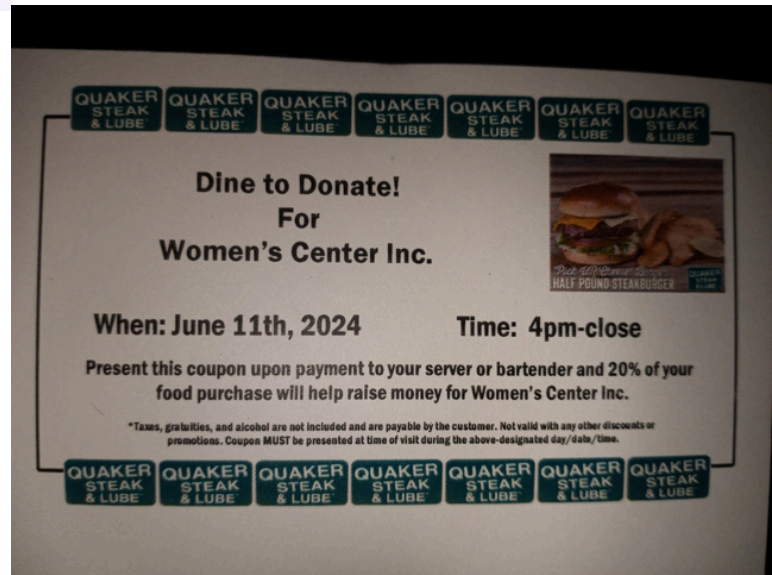

Summer Gateways Program

The Women's Center, Inc. offers an eight-week summer day camp for children who have been exposed to domestic violence and sexual assault. The sessions begin the end of June and runs until the beginning of August, meeting once a week for almost a full day. Gateways combines community involvement with structured activities to provide an educational and fun experience! Children are encouraged to be creative, to interact cooperatively and to express their individuality.

Every session is centered around a theme to help them realize that violence is never a good solution and show them non-violent alternatives. This year's Gateways activities include: Knoebels, the pool, visits to the Police and Fire Stations, Rohrbach's Farm, and so much more! The Gateways program is offered at no cost to the participants.
